| On December 11, 2002, the Ontario Energy Board exercised its authority under section 44 of the <i>Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998</i> , to make the Gas Distribution Access Rule. | 4 |
| Enbridge Gas Distribution ("Enbridge") and Union Gas Limited ("Union") have appealed certain provisions of the Rule dealing with billing, and the Court of Appeal has granted leave to appeal. Enbridge has requested the Board's consent to a stay of those provisions of the Rule that are in issue on the appeal, including Chapter 6 of the Rule.
