## Re: Data Models for Cost of Service Filing Requirements for 2023 Rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued an updated version of its *Filing Requirements for Electricity Distribution Rate Applications* (Filing Requirements) for small electricity distributors on December 16, 2021<sup>1</sup>. These new Filing Requirements come in advance of the anticipated 2023 cost of service rates applications from electricity distributors with 30,000 customers or less.

Today, the OEB is issuing the Chapter 2 Appendices Model, which includes the following changes:

- A new tab 2-JD that allows distributors to report Operations, Maintenance, and Administration (OM&A) by USoA accounts.
- Two new rows in Appendix 2-K for splitting up the total compensation by Capital and OM&A.
