# RPPAG Recommendations – IESO-Related

- Revised recommendations to reflect the RPPAG's feedback at the August 19<sup>th</sup> meeting
  - OEB staff considers those recommendations to essentially be final and believes no further discussion is required
  - Specific wording can be addressed in drafting the RPPAG document to the OEB Executive team
  - We can discuss a recommendation(s) if a member has a *material* concern in terms of *substance*



### Proposed RPPAG Recommendations – Other

- General Education on the Regional Planning process in Ontario
  ✓ Full consensus
- 2. Open Stakeholder Access to Electricity Planning Information ✓ Full consensus – IESO share information (scope TBD)
  - ✓ Broad support but not full consensus IESO licence obligation
- 3. Holistic Coordination of Planning Processes Regional, Bulk, Distribution, Natural Gas, Municipal
  - ✓ Appears only Electricity & Gas coordination may require further discussion
- 4. Remove Option to Bypass IRRP process (i.e., directly to RIP from Scoping Assessment)
  - ✓ Broad support but not full consensus
  - ✓ Staff uncertain if any member beyond IESO opposed
- 5. Make information available related to existing hydro capacity not being utilized (i.e., spillage) that OPG did not already agree to as part of <u>Settlement Agreement</u>)
  - ✓ Information will <u>not</u> be used to improve regional planning process
  - ✓ Appropriate process is next OPG proceeding to seek information
  - ✓ Out of Scope for RPPAG

## **RPPAG Document to OEB Executive**

- OEB staff will prepare a first draft using the table as a basis
  - In terms of level of detail. OEB staff excepts similar to Natural Gas Planning & Electricity Region Planning coordination document
- For inclusion in the document to the OEB, a recommendation will require majority RPPAG member support
  - If a member does not support a recommendation, a reason should be provided (via e-mail) given the extent of discussion to date
  - If a member is indifferent, it's ok to remain neutral (i.e., no position)
- If there is majority support, but not full consensus, how that is reflected in the document will need to be agreed upon



### Next Steps and Action Items

- If any outstanding issues remain related to any recommendations, the intent is to address via e-mail
- OEB staff to draft document to be provided to the OEB Executive setting out the RPPAG's recommendations
- RPPAG members to review draft document in advance of next meeting
- Date of next RPPAG meeting TBD
  - It is not certain how long it will take to complete a first draft of the document (particularly if outstanding issues)
  - Date will likely be set once OEB staff is close to completing a first draft
    - RPPAG members will need some time to review prior to meeting
