DELEGATED POWERS AND DUTIES: COST AWARDS

The powers and duties of the OEB under section 30 of the OEB Act to award costs in respect of a notice and comment process under section 45 or 70.2 of the Act or any other consultation process initiated by the OEB.

This delegation is subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

- 1. The delegation includes any incidental powers and duties that a panel of Commissioners would have in exercising the power or duty if the power or duty were not delegated.
- 2. Except where prohibited by the Act or another statute, the powers and duties delegated to an employee may be exercised on the employee's own motion.
- 3. Where a conflict exists between two or more delegations of the same power or duty, the most recent delegation prevails to the extent of the conflict.
