Direct Allocation

As an initial step, distributors should identify significant distribution facilities that are 100% dedicated to a single customer classification

- not applicable where some parts of system used for additional reliability
- where test not met, LDCs should still consider functionalization process



Requirements

- Supporting accounting records must exist
- Supporting system design information must be provided (e.g. line diagram)
- Use encouraged only where costs significant



Potential Examples

Working Group discussed several potential areas where Direct Allocation can apply

- Transformer Station owned by the distributor that is 100% dedicated to customer(s) in the same classification
- A feeder that is 100% dedicated to customer(s) in the same classification
- Costs associated with load displacement assets
