Further to our letter of November 1, The Northwestern Ontario Municipal Association Energy Task Force (NOMA-ETF) wishes to identify the following issues that it believes are missing from the *Issues List Based on OEB Direction to Follow Legal Approval Requirements for IPSP and Procurement Process*:

- Does the IPSP outline specific plans for the existing coal fired generating stations to be converted to other forms of fuel?
- Does the IPSP ensure that no community or region of the province is constricted in its ability to function efficiently, or to attract new industry or economic activity requiring significant amounts of electricity?
- Does the IPSP enhance the economic viability of the Province of Ontario?

It is the strong belief of the NOMA-ETF and the region as a whole that these questions should form part of the Issue List to be reviewed by the Board.
