Regional Infrastructure Plan



- Hydro One has initiated the RIP process for six regions
 - expected to be triggered in June and July 2015
- RIP will develop and provide a consolidated wires plan for the Region. It will discuss and provide:
 - picture of <u>all</u> needs already identified as part of the regional planning activities in Needs Assessment (NA), Local Planning (LP), Scoping Assessment (SA), Integrated Regional Resource Planning(IRRP)
 - And a wires plan to address the needs where a wires approach is the best solution
 - Any new needs and a wires approach/plan to address them



RIP report and effort may entail one or more of the following:

- Description of needs and wires planning that has already taken place (e.g. Local Planning)
- Identification and Assessment of any new needs (based on updated load forecast) and wires planning to address it – 10 year planning horizon
- Assessment and Discussion of any long term needs that should be undertaken now or in the next Regional Planning Cycle



The following RIP are planned to be triggered in June/July 2015:

- Greater Ottawa Ottawa Area
- GTA North York
- GTA West Northwestern
- Kitchener Waterloo Cambridge Guelph (KWCG)
- Metro Toronto Central Downtown
- Windsor-Essex
